COVID 19 RESPONSE

- > Successfully fought New York State to bring more vaccines to Rockland County.
- Created "Safety First, People Always." plan to guide Rockland through pandemic including: implementing protective measures, distributing personal protective equipment, and enforcing of cluster restrictions.
- ➤ Initiated "Rockland Forward" to help facilitate safe reopening measures.

Created The Rockland Center for Codes Investigations "RCI" an innovative approach to combating health, housing and fire safety issues – conducted over 26,000 investigations, issued over 32,000 violations and assessed almost \$2 million in fines.

 Provided necessary funding for construction of a state of the art animal care facility.

 Negotiated contract to provide 100% green electricity, saving over \$600,000.

 Broke ground on the Thurgood Marshall Human Rights Monument, honoring his humanitarian contributions to our County.

Revived the Civil and Human Rights Hall of Fame to help raise public awareness about human rights issues and to foster an environment for discussion and education.

Restored the County Office for People with Disabilities to better serve and advocate on behalf of people with disabilities.
